Henry Petroski is the Aleksandar S. Vesic Professor in the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at Duke University. Before coming to Duke in 1980, he was a group leader at Argonne National Laboratory, where he was responsible for research and development efforts in fracture mechanics.

Professor Petroski is author of 13 books, including the best seller *To Engineer Is Human: The Role of Failure in Successful Design* (1985), and is the writer and presenter of the 1987 BBC-television documentary, "To Engineer Is Human," which has been broadcast on PBS. He writes the engineering column for *American Scientist Magazine* and a bimonthly column on the profession for *ASEE Prism*. He also lectures widely and is interviewed frequently on radio and television.
