

Leonid A. Dombrovsky is a Chief Researcher of the Institute for High Temperatures of the Russian Academy of Sciences. He received the Candidate degree in 1974 from the Moscow Institute of Physics and Technology and the Doctor degree in 1990 from the Research Institute of Thermal Processes, Moscow, Russia. His main research interests are infrared and microwave properties of particles and fibres, radiation heat transfer in disperse systems, and combined heat transfer in power engineering. He has published more than 120 research papers, mainly in refereed journals, and the monograph *Radiation Heat Transfer in Disperse Systems* (Begell House, 1996, New York).
