KIAC is now accepting applications for student internships for summer 2019.

Interns will be working in a team of students and faculty *to help manufacturing companies save energy.*



Students will be:

- **Collaborating** with industry personnel to plan for an energy assessment,
- **Visiting** the plant facilities to collect data and find energy savings opportunities
- **Analyzing** plant data and investigating options to determine potential energy savings and estimated implementation costs,
- **Recommending** to industry management on potential energy and financial savings,
- **Tracking** implementation of recommendations through follow-up with company personnel.

The position will be for 40 hrs/wk for 12 weeks in the summer.

Occasional part time work may be available during the semesters and during breaks.
